Grantwriting Do's & Don'ts

Attendees in this session will learn to:

- clearly communicate project purposes, including long-term and collateral project benefits to potential funders
- clearly articulate project goals in terms of scope: community needs, number of people served, firstever service, needed enhancement, etc.
- improve their grant-writing skills in order to articulate their organization's needs using language and grammar that is understandable to both lay people and subject experts.

About the Presenter

Steve Chuckra is a board member and former president of the Lehigh River Stocking Association: a non-profit organization that conducts water monitoring and environmental remediation activities in Carbon and Lehigh County, Pennsylvania. The LRSA maintains over \$40K in water monitoring equipment and operates and maintains a pollution treatment site near Jim Thorpe, PA on behalf of the PA Wildlands Conservancy. Additionally, the LRSA conducts 24 x 7 water quality analysis and annual tributary surveys to promote public awareness concerning environmental issues that have the potential to negatively affect the the Lehigh River as both a fishery and economic/recreational resource.

The LRSA is a partner with the Carbon County Chamber of Commerce, Carbon County Community Foundation, WIldlands Conservancy, Lower Delaware Wild and Scenic Organization, and the Sierra Club. These organizations provide funding and peer networking benefits in support of the LRSA's mission.
