What does PK do?

We offer shelter to homeless adults of Carbon County.

Currently we offer:

- 1) an emergency shelter for men
- 2) a transitional living program for men
- 3) a transitional living program for women

2 DIFFERENT OPTIONS UNDER 1 ROOF (215 N 1st Street)

MEN:

1) Emergency Shelter

2) Transitional Living Program

WOMEN - 131-133 N 1ST STREET

1) Transitional Living Program - currently OPEN and OPERATING

2) Emergency Shelter - undergoing renovations - OPENING SOON

RULES ARE THE SAME FOR BOTH MEN AND WOMEN'S SHELTERS

EMERGENCY SHELTERS:

- 1) Open from 7pm 9am
- 2) Only need ID to get in
- 3) Cannot be overly high/intoxicated
- Can get food, shower, good night's rest, & watch TV
- 5) Allowed to stay up to 7 nights while working on alternative housing

Transitional Living Programs:

- 1) Must look for work 30 hours per week until you get a job
- 2) Must pay \$100/week rent once you start getting a paycheck
- 3) Can get \$25 back for each week you pay (up to \$500)
- 4) Must pass a drug test to be accepted and agree to random drug and alcohol testing
- 5) Must attend church of your choice every Sunday
- 6) Weekly peer counseling meetings "Knight Training"
- 7) Must do chores and follow rules
- 8) Must attend AA/NA meetings if applicable if client relapses, they may return to PK after attending a rehab (30 days 1st time, 6 months 2nd time)
- 9) Must be in by 10pm overnight passes permitted
- 10) No deadline on length of stay move out when you are ready (we have never turned anyone away because the beds were full)



Our women's transitional shelter has been up and running since December of 2022.

















We are working on getting our emergency shelter for women up and running!

We believe the County will be covering the renovation costs to rehab the space that will house the Emergency Shelter. However, once that is complete - there will be "start up costs"....




We will be starting with 3 sets of bunk beds and a single twin bed (for the house mom who will live there)




APPLIANCES



THE NEED IS GREAT

Last year 86 different men stayed at our emergency shelter.



Our transitional living programs have assisted over 230 men and women since we began in 2007.

CURRENTLY

Currently there are NO SHELTERS to help homeless women in Carbon County if they do not have children with them.

We get multiple calls every week from women in Carbon looking for shelter.

We must refer them to the women's shelters in the Lehigh Valley - which almost always have waiting lists and no beds
